Grouse Mountain with the exciting Skyride – North America's largest aerial tramway system, 3700 feet above sea level. Entry also includes Theatre in the Sky, Grouse Mountain's high-definition cinema experience, "Born to Fly" takes you up close on a dramatic journey through the scenic beauty of BC. This stunning documentary reveals the highest peaks of BC's mountains, the sparkle of ocean whitecaps and the lushness of rainforest, all from an eagle's perspective

Time at leisure at Lonsdale Quay Market in North Vancouver Evening dinner and overnight

Day 6 Depart for home (B)

Breakfast at the hotel and check-out Time for last minute sightseeing or shopping Transfer to the Vancouver airport for the return flight home
